## Assembly Duties

### Assembly Format

#### 1. Greeting:

- Start with a warm and welcoming greeting for the day.
- Example: "Good Morning, respected Principal, teachers, and my dear friends. Welcome to today's assembly."

#### 2. Special Day/Theme Announcement:

- Mention the theme for the assembly or special day, if applicable.
- Example: "Today, we gather here to celebrate and focus on the theme of „Unity in Diversity.”"

#### 3. Prayer:

- A short prayer or a religious invocation to begin the assembly.
- Example: "Let us all bow our heads for the prayer."  
(A prayer can be specific to the values being observed that day or can be a general one.)

#### 4. Pledge:

- All students stand and take the pledge.
- Example: "Let us all stand for the pledge."  
(Standard pledge text, such as the National Pledge or a custom pledge related to values.)

#### 5. News:

- Share significant national, international, or school-related news.
- Example: "Here's a look at the headlines for today."
  - **National News:** Recent developments in the country.
  - **International News:** Key global events.
  - **School News:** Updates about school activities or achievements.

#### 6. Word of the Day:

- **English Word of the Day:**
  - Example: "Today's English word is „Courage." It means the ability to face fear or adversity."
  - Sentence: "He showed great **courage** when he stood up to the bully."
- **Hindi Word of the Day:**
  - Example: "आज का ह5िंदी शब्द 5ै „स5नशीलता" हजसका अर्थ 5ै कहिनाइय िक स5न करने की क्षमता।"
  - Sentence: "5मारी माँ 5में सहनशीलता हसखाती 5ै।"
- **Kannada Word of the Day:**
  - Example: "ಇವತ್ತಿನ ಕನ್ನಡ ಪದ „ನಿಷ್ಠೆ" ಆಗಿದ್ದು, ಅದು ತಮ್ಮ ಕೆಲಸದಲ್ಲಿ ಸಮರ್ಪಣೆಯನ್ನು ಸೂಚಿಸುತ್ತದೆ."
  - Sentence: "ಅವನು ತನ್ನ ಅಧ್ಯಯನದಲ್ಲಿ **ನಿಷ್ಠೆ** ತೋರಿದ್ದಾನೆ."

#### 7. Special Activity:

- Include an activity related to the theme. It could be a **Skit, Role Play, Music Performance, Poster Presentation, or Quiz.**

#### 8. **Compulsory Awareness:**
